Chapter 2—General Rules**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT**

**20 CSR 2230-2.070 Fees.** The board is amending section (1).

*PURPOSE: The State Board of Podiatric Medicine is statutorily obligated to enforce and administer the provisions of Chapter 330, RSMo. Pursuant to section 330.140.2 the board shall set the amount of the fees which the chapter authorizes and requires by rules and regulations. The fees shall be set at a level to produce revenue which shall not substantially exceed the cost and expense of administering the chapter.*

*PUBLIC COST: This proposed amendment will cost state agencies or political subdivisions approximately one hundred seven thousand nine hundred twenty-five dollars (\$107,925) from December 1, 2017 to February 28, 2018 and forty-seven thousand dollars (\$47,000) biennially for the life of the rule beginning in FY19 and two thousand nine hundred fifty dollars (\$2,950) annually for the life of the rule.*

*PRIVATE COST: This proposed amendment will save private entities approximately one hundred seven thousand nine hundred twenty-five dollars (\$107,925) from December 1, 2017 to February 28, 2018 and forty-seven thousand dollars (\$47,000) biennially for the life of the rule beginning in FY19 and two thousand nine hundred fifty dollars (\$2,950)*

*annually for the life of the rule.*
